## Renaissance Edmonton Airport Hotel

Edmonton is the gateway to the Northwest Territories; land of the oil sands. It is a remote, cold place, with vast resources. It is a place where boots, plaid shirts and jeans are the norm and pickup trucks are the transportation.

The airport in Edmonton was transformed into an international hub and the Renaissance Edmonton Hotel has become its crowning jewel. The exterior of the Renaissance Edmonton is sweeping and modern with a playful rhythm of colored fins. The interior design reflects the aesthetic of the exterior, while drawing inspiration from airplanes and air flight. References to snow and ice and mountain topography in the finishes provide the final connection to the Edmonton region.

A combination of curving wall planes, freestanding pavilions, and millwork screens define different zones of activities within the lobby. The heart of the space is defined by the natural wood surface of a floor, which becomes a wall, which becomes the bar, culminating in a live edge natural wood bar top.

Other features include a private lounge which feels like the inside of an airplane with views of local Elk Island, oil rig patterned chairs, and bathrooms inspired by bubbling black oil. Nestled in a quiet corner is the library. With grey wood floors, comfortable seating groups, and book and artifact filled millwork the library is a cozy respite.




## **Airport Entrance**

## **Reception Area**


Backlit modern reception pods bring Guests in for a landing, while a playful furniture garden keeps the kids entertained.

The heart of the hotel is the Lounge and Bar area. Warm woods and glowing elements create hearth-like spaces while other elements remind us of the airplane we arrived on.






## **Public Lounge**

Jazzy and cool, this area is set for music and entertainment. Even the lights are dancing.








#### **Guestrooms**

Cool colors and fractal patterns make light play of this cold northern location. Jean butt patterns in the bathroom remind of local manufacturing history.






## Lounge
